

Mr. Riske's Class Rules 2007-2008 – Revision 1.1

- 1. Keep your hands to yourself. Physical contact with classmates is not appropriate or permitted, (unless specifically required, requested, and permitted in order to conduct a lab.)**
- 2. Stay in your seat. Do not walk around class, unless directed to do so. During labs, stay with your lab group, unless you are following a specific directive to share materials. If you need to leave your seat, get permission first.**
- 3. Watch your mouth. “Your mama” jokes and all other forms of disrespectful comments, whether serious or joking, are inappropriate and prohibited. Students will exhibit courtesy and respect toward all other students and staff at all times.**
- 4. Raise your hand to be recognized.**
- 5. Listen carefully when the teacher, guest speaker, or another student is speaking.**
- 6. Exhibit Self-control. Disruptive behavior is disrespectful and irresponsible.**
- 7. Nothing should go airborne without my explicit permission and directive.**
- 8. Excessive personal grooming is to be done in the restrooms only.**
- 9. No excessive gum, candy, or food in the classroom. Use your better judgment. (Poor judgment, such as disrupting class with loud wrappers or popping gum or such as failing to ensure that trash makes it all the way into the garbage can at the end of class, will quickly result in the revocation of this privilege.)**
- 11. Talking during tests is not permitted. Failure to adhere to this rule will result in a zero on the test (including semester exams).**
- 12. Students will be dismissed only after the classroom area has been cleaned, lab materials, and books returned to their proper places.**
- 13. In order to ensure the safety of all students, the St. Lucie County Code of Conduct and PSLHS Student Handbook will be enforced at all times.**
- 14. Where not otherwise specified, violation of these rules will result in the following:
1st Violation – Verbal Warning
2nd Violation – Time-out with the broken rule written out 100 times
3rd Violation – Written Referral**
- 15. Both copies need to be signed by you and your parent/guardian. The first copy will go into your binder and second copy will remain with the teacher.**
